 managers for leadership and larger roles that will strategically add value to Genpact's clients. The unique
 holistic curriculum addresses overall personality development as well as more traditional leadership topics
 and tactical subjects on Genpact's business.
- Achieving operational transformation for its clients Genpact imbeds L&D throughout its transformation engagements which can include transferring employees from a client to Genpact. Genpact deploys a best-inclass standardized approach, "First Time Right (FTR)," part of its Lean Six Sigma methodology, to avoid errors in the process knowledge transfer. This phase of the engagement is critical to client success and helps lower costs, avoid business disruption, and achieve transformation.
